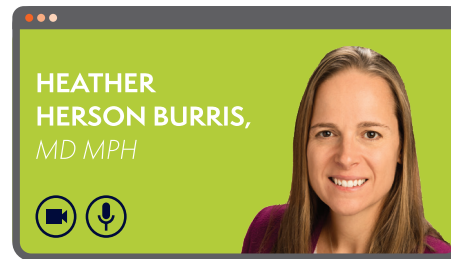

Racial Disparities in Birth Outcomes:

Considering the Environment Outside of the Hospital Walls

In the United States, our NICUs are disproportionately populated by non-Hispanic Black infants because of high preterm birth rates among Black women. Heather Burris' work challenges all of us to move outside of our hospital walls to consider factors beyond individual women's control such as pollution and exposure to neighborhood violence that together may contribute to unequal chances at a healthy term birth. She proposes that a societal movement will be required to address inequity that starts before an infant even takes a breath.

Laura Sherlock is an Assistant Professor in Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine at University of Colorado, who was drawn to the field with a deep calling to advocate for sick neonates and connect to parents during a time of vulnerability. As the victim of a hit and run accident while 34 weeks pregnant in 2010, her experiences as a patient and parent have enhanced and nurtured her resilience as a provider. Her personal and professional growth has been built on a foundation of practicing compassion to self, others on the medical team, as well as families.

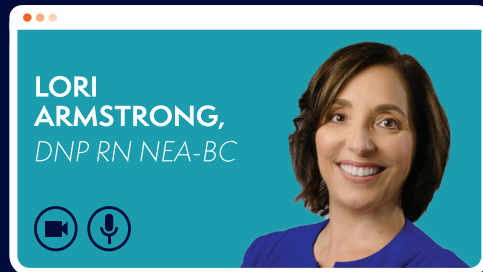
**Ethical Considerations

He is one of the founding members of the ethics consult service at Texas Children's Hospital, and a member of Baylor College of Medicine Center for Ethics and Health Policy. He will also explore how perspective influences how we view the "truths" of prematurity.
